BABIES ROOM

In the baby room, we have been celebrating some special days, National Space day – we explored outdoor and different ways of making marks using paints. We have been doing baby yoga in the garden too, encouraging babies to stretch and explore their bodies in many different ways. We are also exploring Elmer and have been busy doing lots of creative activates in the garden, such as mark making, dressing up, painting and singing too!

TOTS ROOM

In the Tots' room we have been carrying out lots of exciting activities based on children's interest. This month we have been focusing on using our senses and the children have shown a great interest in dinosaurs, so we have been making a dinosaur swamp, an obstacle course and a cosy dinosaur reading area! ©

TODDLER ROOM

This term the children have been growing their own sunflowers, they have been looking at the different colours and talking about their own experiences and how flowers grow and bloom, the children have then been able to take their own flowers home too to show their families! Following on another interest children have been creating music and exploring different sounds by banging, singing, tapping and shaking different musical instruments.
